Bill Analysis

SB 329 authorizes the state Legislature to disapprove the implementation of any federal regulation or rule imposed on a state agency via a joint resolution. State agencies are required to submit notice to the President Pro Tempore, Speaker, and Governor upon receiving instruction to submit to any new federal rule or regulation. Rules or regulations disapproved by the state Legislature shall not be followed, interpreted, or abided by any state agency. Should the Governor successfully veto a joint resolution disapproving the adoption of a federal rule or regulation, the rule or regulation will stand.
