Bill Analysis

SB 33 defines “vapor product” in the Tobacco-free Schools Act. A vapor product is a noncombustible product that may or may not contain nicotine that employ a mechanical heating element, battery, electronic circuit or other mechanism, regardless of shape or size, that can be used to produce a vapor in a solution or other form. The measure also prohibits the use of a vapor product in or on any educational property teaching children in pre-kindergarten-grade 12. SB 33 also authorizes schools to adopt more restrictive policies.
