Bill Analysis

SB 336 defines the terms “winemaker” and “satellite tasting rooms” within the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Control Act. Such rooms must provide wine produced by the holder of a winemaker or small farm winery license. The measure authorizes winemakers to obtain a separate satellite tasting license to establish up to two separate locations for the express purpose of allowing customers to sample products. The fee for the license is \$100.00. The measure also provides for a small farm winery licensee to possess the same authority as a winemaker licensee.

House Amendments

House Amendments to SB 336 provides for a small farm winery licensee to possess the same authority as a winemaker licensee and adds new requirements as it relates to serving wine in a tasting room.
