**Committee Substitute (CS)**

The CS for SB 378 authorizes any public or private commercial driving school that has or maintains a program instructing students for a Class A, B, or C license to hire designated examiners of the Department of Public Safety to be third-party testers upon receiving approval from the Department. The Department is directed by the measure to adopt a curriculum of required courses and training to be offered to third-party testers. Third-party testers are subject to an annual criminal background check by the Department. Fees for the background check are to be borne by the third-party tester or third-party tester applicant. The Department is directed to promulgate rules to implement the provisions of the measure.
