Bill Analysis

SB 378 authorizes any public or private commercial truck-driving school that has or maintains a program instructing students for a Class A, B, or C license to hire designated examiners of the Department of Public Safety to be third-party examiners upon receiving approval from the Department. The Department is directed by the measure to adopt a curriculum of required courses and training to be offered to third-party examiners. Third-party examiners are subject to an annual criminal background check by the Department. Fees for the background check are to be paid by the third-party tester or third-party tester applicant. The Department is directed to promulgate rules to implement the provisions of the measure.

House Amendments

House Amendments to SB 378 removes the requirement for the instructing programs to operate under the State Board of Career and Technology Education and replaces "tester" with "examiner."
