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Bill Analysis

SB 383 requires long-term care administrator license applicants to submit to a national criminal history record check and extends the license period from one year to two years. The measure also requires the Oklahoma State Board of Examiners for Long-Term Care Administrators to recognize the Health Services Executive qualification from the National Association of Long-Term Care Administrators Board as an acceptable standard of eligibility for licensure.

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
