## **Bill Analysis**

SB 423 amends the definition of "confirmation test" and "sample" standards in the Workplace Drug and Alcohol Testing Act. Urine, saliva, hair or blood samples may be used to test for the presence of drugs. Breath, saliva or blood samples may be used to test for the presence of alcohol. Confirmation tests must be conducted in accordance with the rules of the State Board of Health and no longer need to be conducted on the same sample.
