**Bill Analysis**

SB 43 provides school support personnel, as defined in Section 26-103 of Title 70, a stepped pay increase beginning in the 2019-2020 school year and concluding in the 2021-2022 school year. School support personnel will receive a \$1,500.00 pay increase in 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 respectively and a \$2,000.00 pay increase in 2021-2022.

Additionally, part-time personnel will receive a pro-rated raise. School districts will be prohibited from lowering the amount of hours for support personnel for the purpose of preventing or offsetting the raise. School districts may not increase the amount of hours for support personnel to qualify for the raise.
