Committee Substitute (CS)

The CS for SB 441 prohibits school districts that do not meet or exceed the statewide average performance of students on assessments beginning in the 2020-2021 school year from adopting a four-day school week policy. Additionally, schools that are eligible to adopt a four-day school week policy must provide proof to the State Board of Education that the adoption of such a policy yielded cost savings during the prior school year.
