Floor Substitute (FS)

The FS for SB 441 modifies school-hours policies. Beginning with the 2020-2021 school year, a school district may adopt a school schedule lasting at least 1,080 hours with no minimum amount of days of instruction per school year if it meets or exceeds the minimum guidelines for student performance and school district cost savings established by the State Board of Education. If a school adopts a school-hours policy with at least 165 days of instruction, the school must receive permission from the State Board of Education, but does not need to meet the minimum guidelines. The Oklahoma School for the Blind and the Oklahoma School for the Deaf are exempted from the provisions of the measure, provided the school receives approval to adopt a school-hours policy from the State Board of Education.
