Bill Analysis

SB 52 prohibits public schools, charter schools, and virtual charter schools from utilizing state appropriations to contract with an individual or business entity to provide private extracurricular lessons to students. As defined by the measure, extracurricular activities include but are not limited to gymnastic lessons, music lessons, and athletic performance lessons. The measure does not apply to teachers contracted by the schools.
