**Bill Analysis**

SB 532 authorizes secured parties that meet the requirements set forth in SQ 788 for dispensaries, growers, and processors to continue the operation of a foreclosed medical marijuana dispensary which ceases operations. Secured parties may only operate the business of a foreclosed dispensary for a reasonable amount of time. The Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority must promulgate rules on disposition of certain items.
