**Bill Analysis**

SB 535 creates the Parental Rights Vaccination Act. The measure requires health care providers to obtain informed consent in writing and verbally from the parent or legal guardian of a child before administering a vaccine. Informed consent requires the provider to provide relevant information regarding benefits and risks of the vaccine as well as information concerning the National Vaccine Injury Compensation Program. The measure further requires providers to provide a copy of the Vaccine Information Statement and making available for review the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's "Epidemiology and Prevention of Vaccine-Preventable Diseases: Vaccine Excipient and Media Summary."
