**Bill Analysis**

SB 576 requires every school employee to report suspected abuse of a student under the age of eighteen to the Department of Human Services. For suspected abuse involving a student over the age of eighteen, teachers are directed to report the matter to local law enforcement.

This bill requires school employees who have reason to believe that a child is a victim of abuse or neglect to report the matter immediately to the Department of Human Services.
