Committee Substitute (CS)

The CS for SB 606 requires owners of vending machines dispensing whole fruits and packaged foods to acquire a permit for unattended food establishments from the State Department of Health. Unattended food establishments must be established in buildings not generally accessible to the public and must dispense foods approved by the Food and Drug Administration and must be equipped with certain refrigeration or freezer units. Owners of such an establishment must service the establishment on a scheduled basis and at a frequency acceptable to the State Department of Health. The license fee for each location is set at \$150.00 per location.

Fiscal Analysis

FY'20 Impact: Minimal

Full Year Impact: \$9,468.40 in revenue

SB 606 will create a license for unattended food establishments. OSDH expects a one-time cost of \$10,000 to enhance the current license database and a recurring cost of \$4,481.60. Expected revenues are \$13,950. All estimates are based on 300 expected license holders.
