Bill Analysis

SB 621 modifies procedures related to pelvic examinations for unconscious female patients. The measure requires a patient to give prior verbal or written informed consent or for the patient to be unconscious and the examination is for diagnostic purposes. A physician may also proceed with the examination if the examination is within the scope of care for the surgical procedure or diagnostic examination scheduled to be performed.
