**Floor Substitute (FS)**

The FS for SB 629 updates the approval requirement by the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services as it relates to creating a standard medication fee for participation in an opioid substitution treatment program for recipients of Medicare or Medicaid. The Department must still approve the medication fee if the program participants are recipients of Medicare or Medicaid. The measure authorizes the opioid substitute treatment program to determine the medication fee if participants are not recipients of Medicare or Medicaid.
