Bill Analysis

SB 636 requires all law enforcement agencies in the state to adopt policies and procedures related to electronic recording of a custodial interrogation of an individual suspected of homicide or a felony sex offense that is conducted at a place of detention. Policies must include the requirement to electronically record the entirety of the interrogation, the requirement to electronically record a defendant electing to sign a written statement, procedures for storing the recordings, and a statement of exceptions outlined in the measure.

House Amendments

House Amendments to SB 636 changes the word “in” to “of” as it relates to reference law enforcement of the State.
