**Bill Analysis**

SB 647 requires contractors to provide additional information to state agencies that award a contract worth more than \$50,000.00. Contractors must provide a bond equal that protects against failures as a result of expected usage and weather conditions as well as inadequate workmanship or materials in addition to other requirements in current law. The bond must last up to five years as determined by the awarding agency.
