**Bill Analysis**

SB 653 allows for the accreditation of credit hours for in-plant electrical construction work as it relates to qualifying for an application, examination and licensure as an electrical contractor. The applicant must have been a journeyman for at least two years and must meet all electrical contractor qualifications. The applicant must provide proof of electrical construction work performed. The measure lists what electrical construction work shall be accredited to an applicant for purposes of calculating credit hours. The Construction Industries Board shall determine at its discretion the amount of hours it will certify to an applicant.
