**Bill Analysis**

SB 66 requires the court overseeing divorce proceedings to encourage parents to promote a close relationship between the child and parents as well as minimize exposure of the child to parental conflict. The court must also encourage the parents to communicate and cooperate in matters related to the child. The measure further states that any attempt by one parent to alienate the child from the other parent may be determined to be contrary to the best interests of the child, resulting in a modification of the child custody order.
