**Bill Analysis**

SB 691 authorizes vehicles designed to be used in emergency situations to transport personnel and to suppress fires to operate with a maximum gross weight of 86,000 pounds. Persons operating a vehicle 750 pounds or more above the maximum weight limit shall, upon conviction, receive a fine based on the exceeded weight. The measure provides for increased penalties upon second and third convictions. If a person is not assessed a criminal fine, the Commissioner of Public Safety or designated representative may assess an administrative penalty.
