Committee Substitute (CS)

SB 70 directs the State Board of Education to issue a request for the selection of a statewide student information system by December 31, 2019. The measure directs the Board to create a pilot program implementing the selected statewide student information system for two years before fully incorporating and operating the system on a statewide basis. The CS directs the Board to develop a structure to incentivize school districts to participate in the pilot program. The Board may implement a statewide program based on the success of the pilot program. The Board may establish a fee for district participation.
