**Bill Analysis**

SB 723 authorizes marinas to own and sell beer and wine from a retail store on its property in accordance with rules promulgated by the Alcohol Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission. The measure creates a special marina beverage license. The license authorizes marinas to sell wine and beer in stores located on premises owned by the marina. Such stores must be located in counties that have authorized the sale of alcohol by the drink. All employees handling beer and wine must have an employee license issued by the ABLE Commission.

Marinas must purchase from a licensed wine wholesaler or beer distributor. The measure also defines “marina” as it applies to this section of law.
