Bill Analysis

SB 725 adds the Governor as an ex officio voting member on the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission. The measure also repeals language transferring the duties of the Commission to the Executive Director and prohibiting multiple members from the same county from serving on the Commission. The measure directs the Governor to appoint two members from non-profit organizations that promote long-term development and marketing of destinations in Oklahoma with more than 300,000 people.

The Commission will be organized by the Governor and each commissioner will be required to take and subscribe to the constitutional and statutory oaths of office and file the oaths with the Secretary of State. The Commission is authorized to meet monthly, but must meet at least on a quarterly basis.
