**Bill Analysis**

SB 726 authorizes applicants under the Alarm, Locksmith and Fire Sprinkler Industry Act to apply for a temporary training license. The Commissioner of Labor is required to issue the temporary license after verifying all relevant forms, fees, and qualifications are in order. The license is valid for ninety days and may be extend once for good cause. A licensee must work directly under a supervisor and shall surrender the license within ten days of being awarded a full license or notice of denial.
