## **Bill Analysis**

SB 744 states that a juvenile adjudicated to have provided or conspired to provide a false report concerning an explosive or incendiary device or perpetrated a hoax concerning an explosive or incendiary device shall be referred to the Juvenile Bureau or the Office of Juvenile Affairs to formulate a plan of rehabilitation. The court may also suspend the juvenile's license.

## Fiscal Analysis

FY'20 Impact: \$22,344.00

Full Year Impact: \$33,855.00

SB 744 pertains to minors who make a false report of an explosive device, perpetrating a hoax of an explosive device, or conspiring to make a false report of an explosive device. The court shall turn to OJA to formulate a plan of rehabilitation. Currently OJA can accomplish the intent of the bill using present resources. With an annual estimate of 15 cases per year, the cost will be approximately \$33,855 to OJA. This is based on one current case worker taking over all 15 annual estimated cases.
