Floor Substitute (FS)

SB 750 creates the Educators' Professional Liability Insurance Program. The Program shall provide liability coverage for part and full-time employees of public schools. The FS requires all employees of public and charter schools to participate in the program. Liability coverage is capped at \$2 million per occurrence. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) is directed to manage the program and the Legislature must provide an annual appropriation equal to the costs of the program. OMES and the State Department of Education must notify eligible employees about the Educators' Professional Liability Insurance Program.

The FS also authorizes the Risk Management Administrator to obtain or provide insurance coverage, self-insurance or any combination of the two for any school district requesting loss prevention or insurance services. The Risk Management School District Revolving Fund is created to fund this service and shall consist of monies provided by the Legislature and the fees and fines collected by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services related to insurance premiums.
