## **Bill Analysis**

SB 750 creates the Educators' Professional Liability Insurance Program. The Program shall provide liability coverage for part and full-time employees of public schools. Liability coverage is capped at \$2 million per occurrence. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) is directed to manage the program and the Legislature must provide an annual appropriation equal to the costs of the program. OMES and the State Department of Education must notify eligible employees about the Educators' Professional Liability Insurance Program.
