Floor Substitute (FS)

The FS for SB 766 reduces the time served before a person convicted of aggravated manufacturing or trafficking of a controlled dangerous substance is eligible for parole and removes the penalty from the list of 85% sentences. The time served is reduced from 85% of the sentence to 65% of the sentence received. Additionally, the measure allows a person convicted of aggravated manufacturing or trafficking of a controlled dangerous substance to apply earned credits for parole after serving 65% of the sentence.
