**Bill Analysis**

SB 794 specifies the transportation costs for transporting a defendant to court owed by a bondsman shall be the actual miles traveled in transporting the defendant at a rate equal to the IRS Federal Mileage Rate, except for instances in which the defendant is transported by a contractor. The measure also specifies the bond for a defendant shall be exonerated if there is an added or amended charge to a case that would result in a higher fine or longer term of sentence if convicted. Any premium paid by the defendant to the bondsman shall be set at the same premium rate.
