Bill Analysis

SB 810 creates the Oklahoma Wine Industry Development Commission. The Commission shall be regulated by the Commissioner of the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry and will be comprised of seven members appointed by the Commissioner. The Commission shall serve as an advisory body responsible for developing a statewide long-term plan and marketing strategy for Oklahoma small farm wineries and the grape and wine production industry of this state. The Commission shall assist in the creation of a grant program designed to distribute awards to various wineries in the state. The grant program may receive an initial appropriation from the Legislature. The measure creates a revolving fund for the new Commission.
