**Bill Analysis**

SB 83 strikes language requiring the Commissioner of Public Safety to collaborate with the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control when designing commercial drivers' license training regimens. The measure also authorizes the Commissioner to utilize or establish industry specific materials for use in the instruction required on the recognition, prevention and effective reporting of human trafficking for people training to obtain a commercial drivers' license.
