SB 923 directs the Wildlife Conservation Commission to create a three-day and five-day special use permit to be purchased by a landowner possessing land of 200 acres or more. The permit will authorize residents and nonresidents with the permission of the landowner to hunt and fish on the tract of land. The price of the permit is capped at \$500.00.

SB 923 creates a 3 and 5 day special use permit for landowners to allow individuals to hunt and fish on their land without a license. The fee for the permit is capped at \$500. This would increase revenue for the Department, but could reduce revenue from other licenses that may not be otherwise issued due to the creation of this permit.
