**Bill Analysis**

SB 949 requires the director of each state agency to notify the Legislature of each instance a state employee receives a raise greater than 2% of his or her salary. Written notice must be provided to the President Pro Tempore and Speaker and explain why the raise was given.

**Fiscal Analysis**

FY '20 impact: \$0

Full year impact: None expected

This bill requires the Legislature to be notified of any planned pay increase for a state employee that exceeds 2%. Members of boards and commissions, institutions under the administrative authority of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, and employees of public school districts are exempt. Since this bill only requires notification and does not include any penalty for failure or late notification, no costs are expected.
