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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:			
18	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified			
19	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 188 of Title 8, unless there is			
20	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:			
21	A. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, after a			
22	period of eighty-five (85) years since the last recorded activity on			
23	a burial space, as defined by Section 7102 of Title 36 of the			
24	Oklahoma Statutes, and after a reasonable search for heirs and			

beneficiaries, an unused burial site shall be abandoned and the right of ownership in the burial site shall revert to the private or public cemetery, after the cemetery has met the requirements of this section. This subsection shall not apply to a burial site where the owner provides notice to the private or public cemetery of his or her intent to be exempt from the burial space reversion requirement provided in this subsection.

8 B. 1. A reasonable search for heirs and beneficiaries pursuant9 to this section shall include:

10 a. sending a certified letter of notice by the entity 11 responsible for the cemetery to the last-known address 12 of the record property owner; however, if no address 13 is available, then no letter shall be required, and 14 b. publishing a copy of the description of the abandoned 15 burial space in a newspaper qualified to publish 16 public notices pursuant to Section 106 of Title 25 of 17 the Oklahoma Statutes in the county of the last-known 18 address of the record owner for three (3) weeks; 19 however, if no address is available, then publication 20 shall take place in the county where the burial space 21 is located.

22 2. If no person proves ownership of the burial space within one
23 (1) year after the publication, the burial space shall be deemed
24 abandoned for purposes of this section.

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1	C. Any person with a legitimate claim to a burial space that
2	has been deemed abandoned pursuant to this section and has been used
3	or sold by the private or public cemetery shall have the claim
4	settled by receiving an equal burial space in an equivalent location
5	as the burial space that reverted to the private or public cemetery.
6	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
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
