1 motorcycles; reauthorizing the Folds of Honor Supporter license plate; reauthorizing the Sooner 2 State ABATE license plate; creating the Monarch Butterfly license plate; creating the Oklahoma Tennis 3 Foundation license plate; creating Veterans of Foreign Wars license plate; creating the Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization license plate; creating 4 the FIRST license plate; creating Pittsburg State 5 University license plate; creating Historic Greenwood District license plate; providing for design consultation; updating statutory reference; creating 6 the Monarch Butterfly License Plate Revolving Fund 7 and providing for deposit of specified funds thereto; providing for purpose of, and expenditures from, the Monarch Butterfly License Plate Revolving Fund; 8 creating Historic Greenwood District/Juneteenth 9 Festival Revolving Fund; providing for codification; providing effective dates; and declaring an emergency. 10 11 12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: 13 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as 14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY last amended by Section 12, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp. 15 16 2018, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows: Section 1135.2. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby 17 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license 18 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as 19 20 provided by this section. Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other 21 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of 22 23 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used 24

on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
 registered for the current year.

3 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall 4 5 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain 6 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor 7 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be 8 9 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and 10 amateur radio operator license plates.

11 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 12 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept applications for special license plates authorized under this 13 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 14 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 15 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 16 17 information directly into such system and generate a receipt accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 18 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 19 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 20 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 21 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. 22

B. The special license plates provided by this section are as follows:

1 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be 2 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war 3 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification 4 5 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having 6 7 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not 8 9 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by 10 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war 11 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one 12 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 13 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 14 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title; 15

National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide

1 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be 2 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

3 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States 4 5 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or 6 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member 7 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably 8 9 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying 10 for such license plate must show proof of present or past military service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or 11 12 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof 13 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required 14 to provide proof of eligibility annually; 15

5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse

1 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is 2 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the 3 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action 4 5 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each 6 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in 7 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity 8 9 of one (1) ton or less;

10 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be 11 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper 12 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such 13 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration. 14 15 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 16 The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been 17 less. awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not 18 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated 19 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one 20 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 21 The license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee 22 provided by this section for special license plates; 23

1	8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
2	designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
3	United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
4	the United States as being:
5	a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
6	7, 1941,
7	b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
8	7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
9	the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
10	exceed three (3) miles, and
11	c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
12	States Armed Forces.
13	Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
14	for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
15	less;
16	9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
17	any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
18	Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
19	States as being:
20	a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
21	of 1945,
22	b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
23	vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and

c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the UnitedStates Armed Forces.

3 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each 4 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 5 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and 6 7 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB." 8 9 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such 10 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other 11 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the 12 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of 13 registration after the initial issue;

14 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
16 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
17 the United States as being:

- a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
  19
  1944,
- b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
  Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
  participation cannot be verified by the United States
  Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
  the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its

discretion, accept evidence of such participation from the person applying for the license plate, and c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United States Armed Forces.

5 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for 6 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less; 7 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be 8 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were 9 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse 10 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by 11 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action

12 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person was killed in action and that the person making the application is 13 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse 14 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two 15 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) 16 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 17 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 18 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 19 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title; 20

21 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be 22 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were 23 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply 24 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification 1 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making 2 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent 3 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one 4 5 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 6 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 7 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title; 8

9 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be 10 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the 11 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the 12 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or 13 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a 14 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated 15 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

16 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 17 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United 18 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such 19 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each 20 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

21 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be 22 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal 23 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police 24 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and

1 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may 2 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated 3 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of 4 5 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common education police department by either an identification card or 6 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma 7 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for 8 9 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial 10 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of 11 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in 12 consultation with municipal police departments of this state; provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design 13 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in 14 15 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate; World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 16 16. designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United 17 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be 18 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of 19 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having 20 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from 21 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may 22 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a 23 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 24

1 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall 2 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia 3 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps, 4 5 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate 6 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at 7 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. 8 9 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words "WORLD WAR II"; 10

11 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 12 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be 13 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of 14 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having 15 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June 16 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former 17 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for 18 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 19

The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member

1 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the 2 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two 3 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the 4 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

5 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be 6 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and 7 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or 8 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only 9 be produced upon application;

10 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be 11 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are 12 residents of this state. Such persons must present an identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a 13 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with 14 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend 15 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the 16 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and 17 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the 18 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red 19 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design 20 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other 21 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each 22 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue; 23

20. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall
 be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any
 resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars
 organization in this state. Such persons may apply for Veterans of
 Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership in a Veterans
 of Foreign Wars organization. The license plate shall be designed
 in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars organization;

8 21. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed 9 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the 10 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and 11 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert 12 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity 13 of one (1) ton or less;

14 22. 21. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates
15 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present
16 member of a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such
17 persons may apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each
18 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

19 23. <u>22.</u> Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License
20 Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or
21 survivor of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
22 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

23 24. 23. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air

1 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate 2 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 3 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol; 4 5 25. 24. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons 6 7 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation 8 9 with the Ninety-Nines;

10 26. 25. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates 11 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman 12 Badge. The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. 13 Below the badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat 14 15 Infantryman Badge". Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity 16 of one (1) ton or less; 17

18 27. <u>26.</u> Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates
19 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present
20 member of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the
21 United Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia
22 Combat Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
23 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

28. <u>27.</u> Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

29. 28. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
United States Secretary of Defense;

10 30. 29. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be 11 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission 12 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any 13 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as 14 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such 15 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying 16 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

17 <u>31.</u> <u>30.</u> Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be 18 designed for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall 19 designate the house of the Legislature in which the legislator 20 serves and the district number;

32. <u>31.</u> Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United
States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected

1 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which 2 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a 3 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the 4 5 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons 6 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license 7 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no 8 9 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying 10 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or 11 12 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or 13 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans 14 15 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 16 The 17 fee provided by this section for the special license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other 18 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees 19 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this 20 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00). 21

If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be

eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to the Tax Commission;

7 33. 32. United States Air Force Association License Plates 8 such plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air
9 Force Association. Persons applying for such license plate must
10 show proof of membership in the Association. The license plates
11 shall be designed in consultation with the Association;

12 34. 33. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state 13 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons 14 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for 15 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 16 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 17 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the 18 19 Academy;

20 <u>35. 34.</u> Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates 21 shall be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid 22 operator's license, technician class or better, issued by the 23 Federal Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a 24 motor vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been

1 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment. 2 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle 3 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax 4 5 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call 6 7 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All 8 9 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on 10 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee 11 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other 12 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant 13 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license 14 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio 15 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. 9 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as10 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

11 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2368.32 of Title 68, unless 13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund 14 to be designated the "Historic Greenwood District/Juneteenth 15 Festival Revolving Fund" and administered by the Oklahoma Department 16 17 of Commerce. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all the monies 18 received by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce pursuant to the 19 provisions related to the Historic Greenwood District License Plate 20 in Section 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes. All monies 21 accruing to the credit of the fund are appropriated and may be 22 budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce at the 23 beginning of each fiscal year for the purpose of providing grants to 24

support and promote the Historic Greenwood District Juneteenth
Festival in the Historic Greenwood District in Tulsa, Oklahoma.
Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the
State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
approval and payment and in consultation with the Black Wall Street
Chamber of Commerce.

8 SECTION 5. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 6 of this 9 act, Sections 1, 3 and 4 of this act shall become effective November 10 1, 2019.

11 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 12 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
