HB 1052 will double the maximum reimbursement for the unpaid expenses directly resulting from interment or cremation of a honorably discharged indigent veteran from \$500 to \$1000. It also adds that to qualify, no one can claim the remains, and it also allows homeless veterans to qualify, and specifically disallows those veterans in the custody of DOC. However most of the costs are paid for by donations and income tax check-off, and all funds must come from the Indigent Veteran Burial Revolving Fund.
