FY'20 Impact: Incarceration Costs to DOC

Full Year Impact: Incarceration Costs to DOC

HB 2453 establishes misdemeanors and a felony as well as fines and possible imprisonment in DOC custody. The actual impact is contingent upon how many individuals are found guilty of the crime, and the amount of the fine and/or the length of their sentence they are required to pay/serve. Currently it costs an average of \$58.47/day or \$21,339.73/year to incarcerate an individual in DOC custody (based on FY18 actual data).
