PROPOSAL: Amendatory

SB 1149 proposes to amend 68 O.S. §2385.16 by eliminating the Oklahoma Tax Commission's restriction on releasing taxpayers' full social security numbers to entities contracted with implementing a card-based disbursement system for income tax refunds.

No changes in revenue are expected as a result of this proposal; however, a minimal administrative cost to the Tax Commission is anticipated for enhancements to the OneLink GenTax system.
