PROPOSAL: Amendatory

SB 1652 proposes to amend 62 O.S. § 845 to allow the Oklahoma Tax Commission (OTC) to properly remit incentive payments authorized by the Oklahoma Local Development and Enterprise Zone Incentive Leverage Act. This measure converts the existing Oklahoma Local Development and Enterprise Zone Incentive Leverage Act Incentive Payment Fund to an agency special account (ASA) in the State Treasury for the OTC.
