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Committee Substitute (CS)

The CS for SB1046 adds a definition to the Supplemental Hospital Offset Payment Program (SHOPP) Act. “Newly eligible Medicaid population” is defined as those individuals over age 18 and under 65 whose income does not exceed 133% of the Federal Poverty Level guidelines. It modifies the methodology by which the assessment rate of the program fee is calculated by adding an amount fixed at 1.7% for state fiscal year (SFY) 2021 only in order to fund the nonfederal portion of the state’s newly eligible Medicaid population and caps the total assessment rate at 4% for SFY 2021. The measure prevents the Authority from entering into a contract with a private managed care organization in a capitated arrangement to administer benefits and delivery of services so long as Oklahoma State Plan Amendments 20-0023, 20-0024 and 20-0025 are in effect. The CS modifies the Oklahoma Health Care Authority’s transfer and expenditure authority under SHOPP to provide for transfers and use of monies to fund the nonfederal portion of the newly eligible Medicaid population in an amount of \$33,500,000.00 each fiscal quarter. The Authority is directed by the CS to redetermine the assessment amount for state fiscal year 2021 only and send out notices of the redetermined assessment amounts within 60 days of the effective date of this measure.

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
