  B. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require an
  - B. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require an assisted living center to provide or pay for any immunization against influenza for its residents.
  - C. No person shall have a cause of action for any loss or damage caused by any act or omission resulting from providing, or the lack of providing, educational information pursuant to this act.
  - D. The assisted living center's license shall not be affected due to the providing, or lack of providing, the educational information pursuant to this section.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
