HOUSE BILL 1217

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 14-103A, which relates to movement of manufactured homes; modifying allowable size and width; requiring rear escort on certain roadways; allowing only daytime movement on certain roadways; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 14-103A, is amended to read as follows:

Section 14-103A. A. No combination of a motor vehicle and manufactured home or frame or frames thereof shall have an overall length, inclusive of front and rear bumpers, in excess of seventy (70) feet or a width in excess of ~~sixteen (16)~~ eighteen (18) feet while operating on the system of interstate and defense highways.

In determining the width of a manufactured home, the ~~topside overall~~ width ~~may~~ shall not exceed the ~~sixteen-foot~~ eighteen-foot width ~~limit by no more than twelve (12) inches on each side for awnings, doorknobs, or other fixtures extending beyond the body of the unit.~~

Such combination exceeding seventy (70) feet in length or eight and

1 one-half (8 1/2) feet in width must comply with the provisions of
2 Section 14-118 of this title. A rear escort shall be required on
3 the interstate and defense highways for vehicles meeting the
4 parameters of this subsection.

5 B. If any combination of a motor vehicle and manufactured home
6 or frame thereof, exceeds seventy (70) feet in overall length, or
7 eight and one-half (8 1/2) feet in width, they shall be moved only
8 during daylight hours on the system of interstate and defense
9 highways. The towing vehicle must be at least ~~three-fourths (3/4)~~
10 ~~ton~~ three-fourths-ton rated capacity with dual wheels.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
