20	privileges set forth in state or federal law for an individual with
21	a disability.
22	B. Any person who violates the provisions of subsection A of
23	this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

"Qualified service animal" shall mean any dog individually 2 trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual 3 with a disability, including a physical, sensory, psychiatric, 4 intellectual or other mental disability. Other species of animals, whether wild or domestic, trained or untrained, are not service 5 6 animals for purposes of this definition; and 7 2. "Therapy animal" shall mean an animal selected to accompany 8 an individual with a disability that does not work or perform tasks 9 for the benefit of an individual with a disability and does not 10 accompany at all times an individual with a disability.
