6	<u>AS INTRODUCED</u>
7	An Act relating to schools; creating the Oklahoma Educator Loan Repayment Program; directing the State
8	Department of Education to administer the Program; providing educational loan repayment assistance to
9	certain teachers; providing repayment distribution based on contract up to certain amount; directing the
10	Department to establish application process; requiring the Department to establish performance
11	requirements and review certain reports for compliance; requiring certain review for each year of
12	participation in the Program; providing eligibility requirements; authorizing the Department to accept
13	certain funds; authorizing the Department to contract with other entities; creating the Educator Loan
14	Repayment Revolving Fund; providing for appropriations and expenditures of fund; requiring
15	Department to present certain report; defining term; providing for codification; and providing an
16	effective date.

19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
20	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2500 of Title 70, unless there
22	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby created the Oklahoma Educator Loan Repayment Program. The State Department of Education shall administer the Program.

- B. The Program, depending upon and limited to available funding, shall provide educational loan repayment assistance to Oklahoma certified teachers who agree to work in a school district located in the state designated as a comprehensive support and improvement (CSI) school or targeted support and improvement (TSI) school.
- C. Each award shall be for a contracted period and shall be distributed to the sponsoring entity on behalf of the teacher at the end of each contract year with disbursements not to exceed an amount to be established annually by the Department based on the availability of funds. A teacher participating in the Program is eligible to receive awards for four (4) years.
- D. The Department shall develop an application process for teachers to apply for the Program.
- E. The Department shall develop performance requirements for teachers in the Program to ensure the participating teacher meets the requirements set forth in this section and any additional requirements promulgated in administrative rules. Prior to any disbursement, the Department shall certify and review reports submitted by the participating teacher detailing performance of activities in accordance with the Program.

F. The Department shall review the performance of the teacher during each year in the Program and determine whether an award may be granted for additional years.

- G. A teacher entering the Program shall agree to be employed and teach in a school designated as a comprehensive support and improvement (CSI) school or targeted support and improvement (TSI) school.
- H. A teacher shall be eligible to participate in the loan repayment program if the individual is a:
 - 1. Teacher that holds a current Oklahoma teaching certificate;
 - 2. Recent graduate from an Oklahoma university or college; and
- 3. Teacher that has met other criteria established by the Department.
- I. The Department may accept donations of public or private funds to assist in funding the Oklahoma Educator Loan Repayment Program. The Department may contract with other public entities and nonprofit corporations for the endowment, management and administration of such funds.
- J. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the State Department of Education to be designated the "Educator Loan Repayment Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the State Department of Education from public and private funds. All monies accruing to the credit of

said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the State Department of Education for the purpose of providing educational loan repayment assistance to Oklahoma certified teachers through the Oklahoma Educator Loan Repayment Program. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

- K. The Department shall present a report on the operation of the Program to the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate within one (1) month of the beginning of each regular session of the Legislature, including but not limited to the progress made in accomplishing the goal of the Program.
- L. For the purposes of this section, "teacher" shall mean a classroom teacher employed in a school in the state of Oklahoma who is a participant of the Oklahoma Educator Loan Repayment Program.

 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
