A new section of law to be codified NEW LAW 21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 49-143.7 of Title 11, unless 22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 23 A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section and 24 except for persons receiving benefits pursuant to Section 49-101 of

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- Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes, effective November 1, 2020, any
 person receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Firefighters Pension and
 Retirement System as of October 31, 2019, who continues to receive
 benefits on or after November 1, 2020, shall receive a four-percent
 increase in said benefits on November 1, 2020.
 - B. Any increase in benefits a person is eligible to receive pursuant to repealed Section 49-136 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes after June 30, 2008, shall be used to offset the increase in benefits provided in subsection A of this section.

- C. Effective November 1, 2020, any persons receiving benefits pursuant to Section 49-101 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall each receive a benefit equal to Seven Dollars and eighty-three cents (\$7.83) for each year of credited service not to exceed thirty (30) years of service.
- SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 50-136.9 of Title 11, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section, any person receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System as of October 31, 2019, who continues to receive benefits on or after November 1, 2020, shall receive a four-percent increase in said benefits on November 1, 2020.
- B. Any increase in benefits a person is eligible to receive pursuant to repealed Section 50-120 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma

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- Statutes, after October 31, 2019, shall be offset by the increase in benefits, if any, provided by this section.
 - SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104K of Title 20, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

- Any person receiving benefits from the Uniform Retirement System for Justices and Judges as of October 31, 2019, who continues to receive benefits on or after November 1, 2020, shall receive a fourpercent increase in said benefits beginning in November 2020.
- SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-305.12 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section, any person receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System as of October 31, 2019, who continues to receive benefits on or after November 1, 2020, shall receive a four-percent increase in said benefits beginning in November 2020.
- B. Any increase in benefits a person is eligible to receive pursuant to subsection B, C or D of Section 2-305 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, after November 1, 2020, shall be offset by the increase in benefits, if any, provided by this section.
- SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 17-116.22 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

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- A. Any person receiving benefits from the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma as of October 31, 2019, other than those benefits specified in subsection B of this section, who continues to receive benefits on or after November 1, 2020, shall receive a four-percent increase in said benefits beginning in November 2020.
- B. Any person receiving benefits pursuant to subsection (3) of Section 17-105 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes whose benefits commenced prior to November 1, 2020, and who continues to receive benefits on or after November 1, 2020, shall receive a four-percent increase in said benefits beginning in November 2020.
- SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 930.11 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- Any person receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement System as of October 31, 2019, who continues to receive benefits on or after November 1, 2020, shall receive a four-percent increase in said benefits beginning in November 2020.
- SECTION 7. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
