L5	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
L 6	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-3-105 of Title 10A, unless
L7	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
L8	A. The Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth shall
L 9	administer a grievance process to be utilized by children detained
20	in a jail, adult lockup or other facility. The grievance process
21	shall be available to a child at any time prior to or after
22	adjudication or conviction or during his or her incarceration.
23	Grievances may be filed either by the child or by anyone acting on

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the child's behalf.

- B. Grievances shall be directed to the Commission's Office of Juvenile System Oversight for investigation, resolution and referral to the appropriate agency if deemed necessary.
- 1. The Office of Juvenile System Oversight shall have the authority to investigate complaints including, but not limited to, the following:
 - a. placement,

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- b. treatment,
- c. psychological services,
- d. social services,
 - e. educational services,
 - f. recreation,
 - g. abuse, neglect or misconduct,
 - h. cleanliness and hygiene, and
 - i. routine problems with employees, contractors or other incarcerated persons within the facility.
- 2. The Office of Juvenile System Oversight shall notify the Office of Juvenile Affairs compliance monitor or designee when a grievance is received. The Office of Juvenile System Oversight shall notify the Department of Human Services when a grievance is received on a child who is in the custody of the Department.
 - C. Each facility in which children are being held shall:
- 1. Make all grievance policies and procedures available upon request to any member of the public;

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1 2. Make grievance policies and procedures readily accessible to 2 any children in the facility; and 3 Explain all grievance policies and procedures to every child 3. 4 during his or her intake at the facility. 5 The Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth shall 6 promulgate rules for the purposes of administering this section that 7 are consistent with grievance procedures available to children 8 detained in juvenile detention facilities as promulgated by the 9 Office of Juvenile Affairs. 10 SECTION 2.
