18	services, including those that directly relate to providing

21	B. Instructional expenditures shall include expenditures

23	1. Salaries and benefits for teachers, teaching assistants,

librarians, library aides and in-service teacher trainers;

 - Student assessments;
 - 4. Technology for students;
 - 5. Supplies; and
 - 6. Purchased services related to expenditures referenced in paragraphs 1 through 5 of this subsection.
 - C. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall apply when related to the expenditure of public funds by school districts. When reporting or publishing the instructional expenditures for any purpose, the State Department of Education shall also report or publish each category of instructional expenditure as listed in subsection B of this section as well as the aggregate instructional expenditure.
- 14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.
 - SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
