L7	Section 1500.1 A. Except as otherwise provided by Section 1500
18	et seq. of this title, the county purchasing agent shall have the
L9	authority to develop, implement and promote policies and procedures
20	that allow the procurement of materials and equipment through
21	contracts that are flexible, value based and are in the best
22	interests of the state and its political subdivisions.
23	B. Except as otherwise provided, the county purchasing agent
2	shall have the authority to use electronic commerce for the

- solicitation, notification, and other purchasing processes. For

 purposes of this subsection, "electronic commerce" means the use of

 electronic methods to enable solicitations, supplier response,

 notice of contract award, county acquisition processes, or any other

 function to make an acquisition.
 - C. Counties shall have the authority to conduct a procurement transaction or online bidding by electronic means subject to the provisions of the Uniform Electronic Transactions Act.

- D. The county shall establish an online bidding process, which
 shall provide:
- 1. A designated opening and closing date and time. At the opening date and time, counties shall begin accepting online electronic bids. Online bids shall be accepted until the designated closing date and time, except as provided by paragraph 6 of this subsection;
- 2. The posting of all online bids electronically and updating of bids on a real-time basis by the county;
- 3. The authorization for the county to require bidders to register before the opening date and time and, as part of that registration, require bidders to agree to any terms, conditions or other requirements of the solicitation or applicable acts;
- 4. The authorization for the county to also require potential bidders to prequalify as bidders and to restrict solicitations to prequalified online bidders;
